Equipment: Recommended automatic liquid laundry injection system.

Use Dilution: Concentration may vary depending on environmental conditions. Your sanitation specialist will accurately adjust the product concentration to suit your specific requirements.

For Use in Automated Dispensing Systems:

1. Sort laundry before washing.
2. Pre-soak or pre-spot laundry as required.
3. Add the appropriate amount of soiled linen to the laundry machine.
4. In the wash cycle, dispense the recommended AllKleen Liquid Laundry Detergent along with AllKleen Release XL or AllKleen Laundry Ultra.
5. For bleaching, dispense this product.
6. In the final rinse cycle, as fabric softener dispense the recommended AllKleen Soft Balance XL.
