- 2. Pre-soak or pre-spot laundry as required.
- 3. Add the appropriate amount of soiled linen to the laundry machine.
- 4. In the wash cycle, dispense the recommended AllKleen Liquid Laundry Detergent along with AllKleen Release XL or AllKleen Laundry Ultra.
- 5. For bleaching, dispense this product.
- 6. In the final rinse cycle, as fabric softener dispense the recommended AllKleen Soft Balance XI.
