#### For Use in Automated Dispensing Systems:

- 1. Sort laundry before washing.
- 2. Pre-soak or pre-spot laundry as required.
- 3. Add the appropriate amount of soiled linen to the laundry machine.
- 4. In the wash cycle, dispense this product together with Allkleen Release XL.
- 5. For bleaching, dispense the recommended AllKleen D-Stain.
- 6. In the final rinse cycle, as fabric softener dispense the recommended AllKleen Soft Balance XI.
