### Directions For Use

#### For Pre-soaking Stainless Steel Flatware:

1. Dilute 2 to 3 oz. of product per 1 Gallon of hot water in a pre-soak pan or sink.
2. Place flatware in pre-soak tank as soon as possible after use.
3. Soak stainless steel flatware in the solution for at least 5 minutes.
4. Rinse with clean water before washing.

#### DO NOT SOAK LONGER THAN 30 MINUTES.

#### DO NOT USE ON STERLING SILVER OR SILVER PLATED FLATWARE.

#### DO NOT USE ON WARE WITH WOODEN HANDLES.

#### For Pre-soaking Aluminum Pots and Pans:

- To remove medium buildup - Dilute 3 to 5 oz. per Gallon for soaking.
- To remove heavy buildup - Dilute 8 oz. per Gallon for soaking.
